

Getting Married in Maine

Obtain your marriage license. You may obtain your license at any town hall in Maine Monday-Friday and need the following items:

- Photo IDs such as a driver's license.
- If this is not the first marriage for one or both of you, bring a certified copy (raised seal) of the divorce or the death certificate of the last spouse.
- Maine does not require a blood test for marriage.

 Please call ahead to the town hall you select to confirm hours of operation of the clerk's office. We recommend arriving to Maine a few days ahead time to obtain your license.

 Maine does not have a waiting period associated with obtaining or using your license and the license is valid for 90 days.
 - We are unable to perform any ceremony without a valid marriage license.
- The Lodge at Moosehead Lake will provide the officiant, witnesses, and file your marriage license. It couldn't be easier!
